Invite you to a talk

“Pocklington Church from Saxon Times”

Thursday 20 June at 7.30pm

at All Saints Church, Pocklington

The talk is being given by local church historian, Chris Bond. He will reveal new revelations about All Saints’ earliest origins in his talk, entitled: ‘Pocklington Church from the Saxon era to the present’. Chris hopes to answer some of the age old issues about the building and outline new perspectives on the history of All Saints, including sharing the results of the 2018 Ground Penetrating Radar study which indicated a pre-conquest church located under the existing one. Chris will also evaluate the evidence of the Norman church, its Early English changes and extensions, the Perpendicular developments, degree of destruction at the Reformation and the impact of Victorian alterations.

Also on show on the evening will be pieces of masonry, some believed to be from the first Norman structure, which were discovered during 20th century restorations. **The event is free to Friends members, but is also open to the public, admission £3.00**, so encourage your acquaintances to come along. Millington Heritage Display at St Margaret's Church

The **Millington Heritage exhibition** supported by 'The Heritage Fund' is now on display at St Margaret's church. The exhibition has been put together by local people gathering information from the community and researching archived references to the area. Due to limited space the display will be changed every 4-6 weeks allowing full information on the local history of the area and the church to be displayed. The exhibition currently displayed gives an insight into the history of the farms in Millington, information about the local farming community past and present is given in detail.

Displays planned for the near future include: **'The History of Millington School'** and **'The Lost Houses of Millington'**. Updates will be published regularly.

We hope that you will visit regularly to learn about the heritage of Millington. The church is **open daily 10am-4pm**. Visitors are encouraged to leave comments in the visitor book and help by giving details of any additional information which could be added to the records of the display.
