Break the Silence - Lift the Shame - Shift the Blame

16 Days of Activism: Members campaign by raising awareness of gender-based violence, through our engagement with the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence campaign. The campaign runs from the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women on 25 November to Human Rights Day on 10 December. Members around the world participate in many ways, by holding prayer vigils, marches, conferences, demonstrations and taking to social media to raise awareness of, and call on decision makers to take action to end gender-based violence. A symbolic act can be done standing or sitting, and we are encouraging everyone to photograph their global moment, and put it on social media on 26 November, to get momentum, using either the hashtag #letstalkaboutit #mu16days, #endstigma or #endgbv.
