PILGRIMAGE INVITATION!

Just after Easter we were invited to speak to the Mothers' Union and tell them about the six years we spent working at Britain's smallest cathedral – the **Cathedral of the Isles** and the retreat house attached to it. These are situated on the beautiful island of Great Cumbrae in the Firth of Clyde in western Scotland. Mothers' Union members were very interested, so much so that they immediately began to ask if it would be possible to go there as a church pilgrimage group, rather like our visit to Lindisfarne in 2015. We have made some enquiries and have made a provisional booking for a 4 night stay with full board from **May 20th - 24th 2019**. There are 16 guest bedrooms, a mixture of single, twin and double, six of which are ensuite. The cost would be around £300 per person plus travel, which would be in shared cars or by train. The ferry to the island leaves from Largs on the Ayrshire coast and takes only 10 minutes! Our programme would provide opportunities for fellowship, worship and prayer together and plenty of time to explore the island. The Cathedral is a beautiful place to stay!
